**SIMS Partner Organizations Strive to Cut Wait Times  
with Groundbreaking Strata Health Software**

As an example of results achieved, before the Calgary Health Region adopted PathWays, their post-acute patients lay in bed up to 19 days longer than required. Post-implementation, the average placement delays dropped to six days.

With the addition of the SIMS partner organizations, Strata PathWays™ will be working on accelerating patient flow in Health Regions and Local Health Integration Networks serving more than eight million Canadians.

“It is an honour that the SIMS Partnership has chosen us to support a ‘best practice’ delivery of improved, faster referral of discharging patients to post-acute care,” said Don Schick, CEO of Strata Health Solutions. “We have had such a productive dialogue with the SIMS Partners and the LHIN during the selection process, and have come to respect their clinicians’ patient-centric vision immensely.
