

Call for Abstracts – **Deadline Extended**

Special Focus on *Nursing in Corrections*

The *Canadian Journal of Nursing Leadership* invites abstract submissions to be considered for full papers focused on issues of *nursing in corrections*. Abstracts should describe the purpose of the paper (e.g., report of research, literature review, case study, perspective, practice innovation), primary concepts and issues to be addressed, and **highlight the specific implications for nurse leaders**. Abstracts should be no more than 300 words and include 3-5 key words. Topics of key interest include: aging-in-place, blood-borne infections, family violence, mental health, psychiatric and mental health nursing, substance misuse, trauma-informed approaches to care, and the role of leadership in ensuring a healthy workforce.

Abstracts must be submitted for review no later than **September 30, 2019**. Submissions will be reviewed by Guest Editor, Prof. Cindy Peternelj-Taylor whose research and scholarship has focused on professional role development for nurses who work in forensic and correctional settings. Authors of selected abstracts will be invited to submit a full manuscript for peer review no later than **November 30, 2019**.
