Call for Abstracts

Special Focus on Nursing in Corrections

The Canadian Journal of Nursing Leadership invites abstract submissions to be considered for full papers focused on issues of nursing in corrections. Abstracts should describe the purpose of the paper (e.g., report of research, literature review, case study, perspective, practice innovation), primary concepts and issues to be addressed, and **highlight the specific implications for nurse leaders**. Abstracts should be no more than 300 words and include 3-5 key words. Topics of key interest include: aging-in-place, blood-borne infections, family violence, mental health, psychiatric and mental health nursing, substance misuse, trauma-informed approaches to care, and the role of leadership in ensuring a healthy workforce.

Abstracts must be submitted for review no later than **September 5, 2019**. Submissions will be reviewed by Guest Editor, Prof. Cindy Peternelj-Taylor whose research and scholarship has focused on professional role development for nurses who work in forensic and correctional settings. Authors of selected abstracts will be invited to submit a full manuscript for peer review no later than **November 15, 2019**.
